Most modern diagnostics of vein disorders



Vein disorders are triggered by venous valve or venous wall insufficiency. These can be promoted by several factors. However, apart from the inherited disposition, age, gender, pregnancies, weakness of the connective tissue as well as our straight posture and lack of exercise also play an important role.

Therefore, during the course of life, varicose veins (varices) of different severity may develop and may lead to serious consequences: vein inflammation, deep vein thrombosis in the leg, leg ulcer (ulcus cruris), overstress of the deep venous system with damaging of the deep veins up to the much-feared pulmonary embolism.



Due to a professional examination and diagnosis as well as an early treatment, these severe clinical pictures can be avoided to a large extent. Our preliminary examination, therapy and aftertreatment program is gentle, aesthetic and painless.



Gentle and aesthetic therapies



In the Cadio Mosel-Eifel Clinic, we use all treatment methods of modern varicose vein therapy. Apart from well-proven methods which we have perfected to the highest degree, useful, new high-tech methods are also used. All interventions are carried out under gentle local anaesthesia which has already been applied in more than 200,000 cases without any complication so far. If desired, the patient can be placed into a light, induced sleep for this purpose.

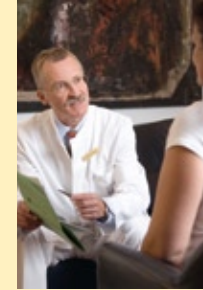


The Cadio Mosel-Eifel Clinic can, in a national and international comparison, produce evidence of the lowest complication and recidivism rate.

Irrespective of the surgical procedure applied to eliminate disordered veins, immediately after the intervention the patients are mobile again. The applied surgical and anaesthetic techniques are not or only slightly stressful for the patient, and are therefore suitable for older patients, as well.



High degree of scientific expertise



For almost 30 years we have offered top quality medical care for all areas of vein disorders, including the treatment of varices, skyrocket capillary ectasis, thrombotic consequences, swellings (edemas), ulcus cruris (leg ulcer) and other disorders of the legs.

Due to our high degree of scientific expertise, we are partner of several universities for future oriented studies which receive worldwide attention. „Lowest rate of recidivism“ In an international comparison, the Cadio Mosel-Eifel Clinic occupies the top position in the area of surgery of varicosity at the saphenofemoral junction in the inguinal region, with a rate of recidivism of only 1.5 percent. According to a scientific study, approximately 43 percent of the patients suffer from the recurrence of varicose veins in this region if such surgery is performed by a non-specialized physician. If such surgery is performed by a vein specialist, the rate of recidivism is 14 percent, and our rate of recidivism is only 1.5 percent.
